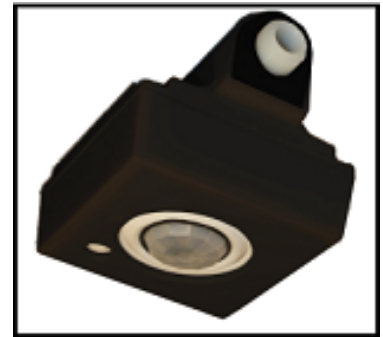
Saving Energy With Dimmable Motion

There are a number of ways to control costs for outdoor lighting solutions, including using timers, motion sensors, and LED Lights. Why not use all of the above, and include a dimmable sensor?!

Timers work well some of the time, but often need to be adjusted at different times of the year, especially after power outages. LED lights are becoming the standard for outdoor lighting...but often times the lights are on, but no one is using them.
