## **15 Years of Newsletters... A Look Back**

Here's a look back at some of the highlights that were mentioned in previous newsletters:

- The first issue (back when the newsletter was called "Energy Buzz") highlighted CFL's (do you remember those curly light bulbs, a.k.a. Compact Fluorescent Lights?)
- Induction Lights were highlighted in mid-2010. They were very popular just before LED's took over
- Energy Management Systems (EMS), Variable Frequency Drives (VFD's) & Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) were first mentioned in early 2011
- Ways to cut telecom costs, along with the telecom "Cloud", where data is stored, was explained in mid-2012
- Fiberoptics and Hosted Phone Systems were highlighted in 2014
- In 2017, additional ways to save energy were discussed: Solar panels, Vending Machine Economizers, Capacitors, Cogeneration, and HVAC (Heating/Ventilation/Air Conditioning) controls
- Redundancy (for both telecom & energy) was mentioned in 2018
- In 2020, we mentioned getting a "Telecom Check-Up", to make sure you're getting the most for your money
- EV Charging Stations were discussed in late 2021

## **Client Corner: St. Francis Catholic, New Britain**



Along with a number of other parishes in CT, St. Francis Catholic is the culmination of 4 merged parishes: St. Francis of Assisi, St. Katharine Drexel, Divine Providence and Holy Apostles, all located in New Britain. Internet service at both locations and coordinating with their IT vendor to install repeaters to drastically cut their monthly costs. The 3<sup>rd</sup> phase included consolidating their telecom bills, removing services that were no longer needed, and implementing cost savings wherever possible.
